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**Emily Griffith Technical College Restructures Finance and Operations Team to Better Support New Student Lifecycle Process**

*School hires Erin Pepper as Vice President of Finance & Operations;  
Promotes Audrey Boller and Uta Greunke*

DENVER - To support the College's new student lifecycle process which was announced in September, [Emily Griffith Technical College](https://www.emilygriffith.edu) has restructured the operations and finance teams. Through these changes, Erin Pepper has been hired as the Vice President of Finance & Operations. Pepper will oversee the business services team, including the treasurer's office and financial aid, as well as operations and compliance for the College. Audrey Boller has been promoted to the Director of Business Services. Uta Greunke has been promoted to the Director of Operations.

"Our goal with these changes is to ensure we keep our focus on the success of our students," said Scott Springer, Interim Executive Director. "This new structure allows for a more efficient process at the college, and ensures we are serving students in the best capacity possible from when they first consider Emily Griffith to when they graduate and beyond."

Just two months ago, the College announced its new student lifecycle system to help students successfully navigate their schooling, education and career. The process includes the Student Navigation Center that houses Career Navigators who will help students choose a career path and a program within that path; the Concierge team, who welcomes students by answering questions and fielding emails to direct current and future students to the right people and resources, and supporting them through their education and career placement; and Career Coaches that are associated with each college who help students during their time in class and connect them with career and job opportunities once they complete their program.

Pepper has been working in education since 2006. For three years, Pepper worked at Vista College. She began as the Executive Campus Director. In 2017, she moved to Denver and worked remotely as the Corporate Director of Operations. In 2011, she was named Executive Director of the Beaumont campus of Kaplan College, a position she held for three years. During this time, she instituted new programs and created a live dental assisting clinic to train students and treat patients in the community. As a first generation college student herself, Pepper's lifelong passion has been to help students achieve their academic goals.



Audrey Boller has been promoted to Director of Business Services. She was previously Business Services Manager.

Uta Greunke is now Director of Operations. She was previously the Grant and Compliance Manager.
