### **Transfer Credit Information**

PN prerequisite coursework completed at Emily Griffith Technical College may be accepted for transfer credit at other institutions.

### **Challenge Tests (not available during remote operations)**

If you believe you have already mastered the course content for a PN Prerequisite course, you may speak with the Health Sciences & Administration Career Navigator about the option to pass a challenge test to meet PN Admissions requirements. Challenge tests are comprehensive examinations that demonstrate competence equivalent to learning achieved in a course offered by a college. Once a student begins a class, they may not take a challenge test for that class. Students may take a challenge test only one time for each course. Challenge examinations from other schools are not accepted.

You must have confirmed payment arrangements to attend class and access course materials online.
