APPRENTICESHIP

With an apprenticeship, you can start working and earning wages in a field while you train for your career. You'll gain on-the-job training supported by a mentor in addition to classroom instruction, with the option to earn an **Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree** along the way. Apprenticeship programs take between 1 and 5 years to complete. Scan the QR code to view our Registered Apprenticeships.



CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

High school students can get a head start on college and career. Work toward a certificate through Emily Griffith and receive college credits for FREE through our Concurrent Enrollment program. FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIPS

Most of our students receive some sort of financial assistance. The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is your gateway to state and federal grants, scholarships, and work-study funds. All CTE programs are eligible for financial aid, with the exception of Nurse Assisting. The average out-of-pocket cost for our students is less than \$2,500. We are largely supported by the Emily Griffith Foundation.



CAREER SERVICES

Our Career Services team supports students and alumni by providing an individual Career Coach to help with your job search, including application assistance, resume writing, interview skills, creating connections with employers, and more. TRANSFERABLE CREDITS

Emily Griffith works closely with area school districts, local community colleges, four-year colleges, and industry to create educational pathways for our students to have seamless transitions from high school into credit-bearing college programs, into degree-granting programs and into the workforce. Our partner institutions in higher education include: Arapahoe Community College, Community College of Denver, CSU Global, Front Range Community College, and Metropolitan State University of Denver.
